OPEN INVITATION TO TEST & RACE ON THURSDAY'S!

Welcome to POWERnights the all-new series of Thursday Evening Summer Motorsport starting August 2007. Its aim is to provide an all-day testing, late afternoon qualifying and short evening sprint race programme for competitors and an action packed 4 hour motorsport entertainment show for spectators.

Racing at POWERnights will be by invitation for various groups of race cars. A total of 4 race groups will feature with double-header races at each event and each race is for open invitation races and NOT rounds of a championship or other series. Each race is run to a 10 minute plus 1 lap format with the second of each double-header race run in **reverse finishing order to the first race results!**

The organisers invite competitors to consider the following and enter POWERnights at 1, 2 or all 3 events this August.

The 2007 POWERnights events will feature at...

1. Silverstone (National Circuit) on Thursday 2 August
2. Donington Park (National Circuit) on Thursday 9 August, and
3. Silverstone (National Circuit) on Thursday 30 August

At each of the 3 events the programme will run to the following standard format...

- 9.00am to 12.30pm - General testing sessions for all 4 race groups
- 1.30pm to 3.30pm - General testing sessions for all 4 race groups
- 3.30pm to 5.00pm - Qualifying sessions for all 4 race groups
- 6.00pm to 8.30pm - Double header 10 minute plus 1 lap races (8 races in total)*
- 8.45pm to 10.00pm - Paddock Awards Ceremony, BBQ and Music (with spectators)

** Second double-header race of the evening will be run in reverse order to the first race finishing order.*

Entry fee for the day is **just £250**** (£300 late entry) **per race car and each Entry receives...**

- ✓ 9am to 3.30pm testing in sessions plus qualifying session and 2 x 10 minute plus 1 lap races
- ✓ Pit garage allocation to early entrants
- ✓ All day MST timing services/reports
- ✓ Team personnel passes x 6, paddock vehicle pass x 1, competitor car park pass x 1
- ✓ Copies of the Event Souvenir Programme x 4
- ✓ Event public adult entry tickets for friends/family, valued at £15 each x 6 (Extra at special rate)
- ✓ Post race evening BBQ Vouchers x 2 (Extra at special rate)
- ✓ Race Number Panels x 2

*** For Entries received by 30 June 2007. Late Entries will be at £300*

TV and Prize Fund...

- ✓ All races will be filmed for a one-hour per event highlights programme for **MOTORS TV**.
- ✓ **£4,000 CASH** prize fund per event (**£500 per race @ 1st £300, 2nd £125 and 3rd £75**)

- ✓ The series comes with support from **Motorsport News** and **Motors TV** along with backing from the MSA, MIA, Silverstone, Donington Park and the BRSCC. **Scalextric** are the first series sponsors to be announced.
- ✓ The series will be promoted via a marketing programme to reach both regular enthusiasts plus new audiences in a 30 minute drive radius to Silverstone and Donington. Over 1 million leaflets will be produced along with posters, advertisements, radio promotions and other PR activity.
- ✓ A spectator audience of c.4,000 is targeted for each evening in this first year.
- ✓ A detailed website at www.powernights.com goes live on Wednesday 6 June.

- ✓ Or e-mail/phone Motion Works (as below) to request a Race Entry Pack by e-mail or post.
- ✓ **All Entries to be sent direct to the BRSCC.** Enter by 30 June to save £50 on the entry fee. (Entry Fee @ £250 up to 30 June or £300 from 1 July to 5-days pre-event). Some race group entries may be via their regular series coordinator as a total group entry.
